What will my child need?

- **A signed consent form.** Please complete on the next page and return to school at least one week before the first day of the course.
- **All equipment is provided by Bike Right**, so you do not need to bring a bike or helmet for your child.
- If the session is outside, please make sure your child has **suitable clothing** for the weather.
